## HOW TO ADJUST A MARTINGALE COLLAR

Place the collar over your dog's head. When the collar is on the narrowest part of your dog's neck (just behind the ears), pull on the D-ring. You should be able to put 2 fingers (1 ½ - 2 inches) in the loop between the slides, as shown in above picture. If the slides are too close together tighten the collar by moving the WIDE slide buckle in or out to get the correct fitting and test it again. If the collar is not fitted properly, especially on a greyhound, your dog may be able to back out of the collar.

Check the collar periodically to maintain the proper adjustment.

Also, **DO NOT attach any dog tags to a D-Ring**, because if the tags get caught in something and your dog tries to free himself, it may choke him.

**A separate tag collar is highly recommended.** If you don't have one, attach the tags to one of the side slides on your martingale collar or order a tag collar from [www.aid4greys.com](http://www.aid4greys.com).
